Itinerary

♦ Day 01 Arrival in Seoul

Upon arrival at Incheon Airport, our English and Russian speaking guide will meet you with the "EURASTECH" sign board and will take you to the hotel in a comfortable car (Hyundai Solati). During the transfer, our guide will give you some useful information and answer your questions, as well as inform the time and place of the meeting for the tour in the following days.







Upon arriving to Seoul lunch at local and after the guide will take you to the unique area and the ideal place to buy souvenirs - Insadong Antique Street, where will give you a free time so that you can enjoy the local food and purchase souvenirs as a memory of your travel or as a gift to your loved ones.







Transfer to hotel and check-in, rest time till evening. After check-in, you can enjoy the hotel's amenities or take a walk nearby the hotel.

For the Dinner we want to offer you a special restaurant in the Seoul N Tower, where you can enjoy not only your meal, but also amazing view of night Seoul.

♦ Day 02 Full day Seoul city tour

Breakfast at a hotel. Our English and Russian-speaking guide will wait for you at the hotel lobby, and will accompany you on a tour. A Full Day tour begins with a visit to the Gyeongbokgung Royal Palace, which is the first of five palaces built during the Joseon Dynasty. You will see the Royal Guard Changing Ceremonies, which performs daily and will introduce you to the era of Korean emperors.







After we will visit The National Museum of Korea houses a vast collection of over 220,000 artifacts from ancient times to the modern era in a wide range of topics, including art and culture. The museum houses a Children's Museum, where visitors can learn more about the nation's history through educational programs and experiences. The outdoor grounds feature pagodas and other stone artworks too large to be on display inside. In addition to galleries with a wide array of national and international pieces, the National Museum of Korea is the stage for a number of cultural activities related to collection, preservation, research and analysis, social training, academic publications, intercultural exchange programs, concerts, and more.







In the evening we offer to visit the famous Korea House (can be changed to another restaurant). The Korea House was opened in 1981. It is a traditional Korean building that introduces the culture and lifestyle of Koreans, where you can experience traditional architecture and a classical atmosphere. The building was built in the style of the Joseon Dynasty's Jagyeong-jeon building at the Gyeongbok Palace. It is the only building built in the traditional architectural style. You will feel its antiquity as you enter the building.







After dinner the guide will accompany you to the hotel where you can take a rest or enjoy the evening Seoul in your free time.



♦ Day 03 Lotte World Tower – Lotte Sky – Spa

After breakfast at the hotel, meeting with your guide, transfer to the Jamsil area to visit Lotte World Tower — the highest building in Korea. Lotte World Tower was designed with a conceptual motif inspired by Korean ceramics and writing brushes. With 123 floors total, the tower is the fifth tallest building in the world, standing at 555 meters. The tower contains galleries, cafés, and a luxury hotel, in addition to a skywalk and an observation deck. It is one of the best spots to appreciate the breathtaking view of Seoul's vibrant city lights.







We will also visit SEOUL SKY that is located on floors 117-123 of Lotte World Tower, the nation's tallest and the world's fifth tallest building. The observatory offers a panoramic view of the entire capital city, beautiful both day and night. SEOUL SKY consists of an exhibition zone, observation deck, sky deck, dessert cafe, sky terrace, lounge, and more.

Lunch in the one of the most famous restaurant in Seoul – included in Michelin guide, located in Lotte Tower. Experience "Emptying, Sharing, and Filling" of Korean cuisine, which has unique taste and flavor, in a contemporary Michelin 1 star restaurant "BICENA" at SIGNIEL SEOUL.







In the second part of the day we offer you the best relaxing experience in the Sulwhasoo Spa (Spa can be changed). You can take a rest and experience a spa in the middle of Seoul in very good traditions of Korean beauty. For those who don't want to take a Spa (male tourists or children) we can offer a shopping time in the Lotte World Tower or visiting Lotte World Adventure amusement park (must be booked in advance).







After Spa our guide will accompany you to the romantic Han river cruise to have an amazing dinner time. **E-land Cruise** – aims to develop a cruise theme park at Hangang River as the iconic attraction representing Seoul. It also aims to promote and familiarize the Hangang River to international tourists as a world famous attraction. Visitors and Seoul residents alike can take a break from the busy urban atmosphere and enjoy a relaxing time while on the cruise.









After a relaxing day, the guide will accompany you to the hotel where you can take a rest or enjoy the evening Seoul in your free time.

♦ Day 04 Flight to Jeju – Arte Museum - Tangerine plantation

After breakfast at the hotel, our guide will help you with hotel check-out and will escort you to Gimpo Airport. Flight to Jeju Island. As soon as you arrive at Jeju Island, a guide will accompany you on the Jeju tour.

For lunch you can try famous Korean seafood dish. It's Cutlass fish with octopus and various seafood – must try food in Jeju Island.







First place to visit here will be ARTE museum. ARTE Museum is an exhibition gallery that uses videos, mirrors, sounds, and fragrance to create a fascinating space where you can appreciate media art using your senses. As soon as you step inside, you'll be embraced by darkness with only the lights and sounds from the media artworks to guide you. The exhibition gallery is divided into 12 spaces according to different themes, such as flowers, waves, and the beach to name a few.







Next stop is Tangerine plantation. Jeju Island is the home of citrus. The white citrus blossoms in the spring while the yellow citrus blossoms in the autumn, covering the beautiful city of Seogwipo.









Jeju Island is very famous for it's black pork, so we will offer this dish for dinner, where you can experience real Korean BBQ with various Korean banchan (side dish salads).







After tour our guide will accompany you to the hotel, where you take a rest after a long day.

♦ Day 05 Hallim Park – Bonte Museum – Tea Ceremony at O'Sulloc

After breakfast at the hotel, our guide will wait for you at the appointed time in the lobby and accompany you on a Jeju tour. Tour will start by visiting an unusual place called Hallim Park. Hallim Park is one of the most popular tourist spots on Jeju Island, reaching almost 100 thousand square meters, and has a variety of gardens that can be enjoyed in any season. Visitors can enjoy Palm Tree Road, Jeju Stone and Bonsai Garden, Water Garden, Subtropical Botanic Garden and much more. The most famous tourist sites in Hallim Park are Hyeopjaegul and Ssangyonggul Caves, known to be the only two-dimensional caves in the world. In addition, a folk village, children's amusement park and outdoor resort facilities make it enjoyable for both children and adults.







Next, we will visit one of the largest tea plantations on the island and will be able to taste the tea that has been grown here. O'Sulloc Museum located in front of the Sogwan tea plantations. It is an exhibition space dedicated to Sullock green tea and Korean tea culture. We will also participate in Tea Ceremony and try different types of tea.







Next stop is Bonte Museum The Bonte Museum was established in 2012 where stunning nature is living in harmony with architecture and landscape as the name of the museum, bonte represent. The museum was designed by internationally renowned architect Tadao Ando who won the Pritzker Architecture Prize which is known as the Nobel Prize of architecture in 1995. This building embeds Ando's philosophy on "architecture and landscape" that buildings need to be harmonized with their



surroundings, not only focusing on its own beauty. The building reflects the founding purpose of an encounter of nature and environment, tradition and modern, and Korea and the world, and to cast a new cultural value.







For dinner we want to offer you high class restaurant MINT. It's mix of Korean and European cuisine. You can experience the fantasy of becoming a lighthouse floating on the sea when you watch the sunrise and sunset over the horizon at Mint. This is a space of romance for you and your family or lover to interact with nature through taste.

♦ Day 06 Jusangjeolli Cliff & Flight to Seoul

After breakfast at the hotel, our guide will meet you at the hotel lobby. We will start our day from Jusangjeolli Cliff. Jusangjeolli are stone pillars piled up along the coast and is a designated cultural monument of Jeju Island. Jusangjeolli Cliff was formed when the lava from Hallasan Mountain erupted into the sea of Jungmun. They are rock pillars shaped like cubes or hexagons of various sizes and almost seem as if stone masons had carved them out. The administration of the district named them 'Jisatgae Rocks' from their old name 'Jisatgae'. The 20m cliff makes it a popular spot for high tide and sea angling. The waves of the high tide crashing into the side of the cliff provide a breathtaking view of the ocean surrounding the pillars.







After transfer to the Jeju Airport, flight to Seoul. Check-in at the hotel and rest. We also can offer transfer and guide service for shopping in the best stores in Seoul.



♦ Day 07 Departure from Seoul

After breakfast at the hotel, our guide will meet you at the hotel lobby and accompany you to the Incheon International Airport for your departure.
