

INDUSTRIAL KOREA TOUR 5D/4N

Itinerary

◇ Day 01 Arrival in Seoul

Upon arrival at Incheon Airport, our English and Russian speaking guide will meet you with the "EURASTECH" sign board and will take you to the hotel in a comfortable car. During the transfer, our guide will give you some useful information and answer your questions, as well as inform the time and place of the meeting for the tour in the following days.



Upon arriving to Seoul lunch at local and after the guide will take you to the unique area and the ideal place to buy souvenirs - Insadong Antique Street, where will give you a free time so that you can enjoy the local food and purchase souvenirs as a memory of your travel or as a gift to your loved ones.



Transfer to hotel and check-in, rest time till evening. After check-in, you can enjoy the hotel's amenities or take a walk nearby the hotel.

Dinner nearby hotel and free time for rest.

◇ Day 02 Incheon Industrial zone – Incheon tour

Breakfast at a hotel. Our English and Russian-speaking guide will wait for you at the hotel lobby, and will accompany you to the Incheon Industrial zone.

In Korea, project complexes are distributed nationwide, and 10 of them are designated as smart green project complexes. In Namdong Industrial Complex, a representative smart green industrial complex, 7.345 passengers were established on an area of 9.574,000 km², and the number of employees reached 100,000. In addition, it can be said that it is an agglomeration of representative Korean manufacturing companies, with annual production of 30 trillion won and export of 4.6 billion dollars. The company's main manufacturing fields are machinery, steel assembly, metal, electrical and electronic, etc.

Lunch in local restaurant.

After we visit Incheon China town. Incheon's Chinatown came into being with the opening of Incheon Port in 1883 and Incheon's designation as an extraterritoriality of the Ching dynasty in the following year. In the past, the area held many stores trading goods imported from China, but currently most Chinese businesses in the area are restaurants. Today, the residents of Chinatown are mostly 2nd or 3rd generation Chinese, descendants of the early Chinese settlers. The area harbors many of the flavors of China, while the traditional culture of the first generation are preserved.



After Dinner in local restaurant, our guide will take you to hotel to take a rest.

◇ Day 03 Full day Seoul city tour

Breakfast at a hotel. Our English and Russian-speaking guide will wait for you at the hotel lobby, and will accompany you on a tour. A Full Day tour begins with a visit to the Gyeongbokgung Royal Palace, which is the first of five palaces built during the Joseon Dynasty. You will see the Royal Guard Changing Ceremonies, which performs daily and will introduce you to the era of Korean emperors.



After we will visit The National Museum of Korea houses a vast collection of over 220,000 artifacts from ancient times to the modern era in a wide range of topics, including art and culture. The museum houses a Children's Museum, where visitors can learn more about the nation's history through educational programs and experiences. The outdoor grounds feature pagodas and other stone artworks too large to be on display inside. In addition to galleries with a wide array of national and international pieces, the National Museum of Korea is the stage for a number of cultural activities related to collection, preservation, research and analysis, social training, academic publications, intercultural exchange programs, concerts, and more.



In the evening we offer to visit Cheonggyecheon Stream. Cheonggyecheon Stream starts from Cheonggye Plaza, just off Sejong-ro Avenue. Cheonggye Plaza roughly covers an area of 2,500 square meters, and is located at the starting point of Cheonggyecheon Stream. The square, created based on the design of traditional Korean bojagi (a colorful wrapping cloth), features the elegant beauty of traditional stonework that is colorful yet refined. The plaza also includes a model of Cheonggyecheon that provides visitors with a bird's-eye view of the restored Cheonggyecheon Stream. At the plaza, there are plaques that provide detailed commentaries on the 22 bridges that span the stream, as well as a number of graceful fountains that add to the ambience of the area. The area commemorates the Cheonggyecheon Stream Restoration Project, and also symbolizes gathering, harmony, peace, and unity.



For the Dinner we want to offer you a special restaurant in the Seoul N Tower, where you can enjoy not only your meal, but also amazing view of night Seoul.



After dinner our guide will accompany you to hotel, where you can take a rest.

◇ Day 04 Lotte World Tower – Lotte Sky – Spa

After breakfast at the hotel, meeting with your guide, transfer to the Jamsil area to visit Lotte World Tower – the highest building in Korea. Lotte World Tower was designed with a conceptual motif inspired by Korean ceramics and writing brushes. With 123 floors total, the tower is the fifth tallest building in the world, standing at 555 meters. The tower contains galleries, cafés, and a luxury hotel, in addition to a skywalk and an observation deck. It is one of the best spots to appreciate the breathtaking view of Seoul's vibrant city lights.



We will also visit SEOUL SKY that is located on floors 117-123 of Lotte World Tower, the nation's tallest and the world's fifth tallest building. The observatory offers a panoramic view of the entire capital city, beautiful both day and night. SEOUL SKY consists of an exhibition zone, observation deck, sky deck, dessert cafe, sky terrace, lounge, and more.

Lunch in the local restaurant.

In the second part of the day we offer you the best relaxing experience in the Sulwhasoo Spa (Spa can be changed). You can take a rest and experience a spa in the middle of Seoul in very good traditions of Korean beauty. For those who don't want to take a Spa (male tourists or children) we can offer a shopping time in the Lotte World Tower or visiting Lotte World Adventure amusement park (must be booked in advance).



After Spa our guide will accompany you to the romantic Han river cruise to have an amazing dinner time. **E-land Cruise** – aims to develop a cruise theme park at Hangang River as the iconic attraction representing Seoul. It also aims to promote and familiarize the Hangang River to international tourists as a world famous attraction. Visitors and Seoul residents alike can take a break from the busy urban atmosphere and enjoy a relaxing time while on the cruise.



After a relaxing day, the guide will accompany you to the hotel where you can take a rest or enjoy the evening Seoul in your free time.

◇ Day 05 Departure from Seoul

After breakfast at the hotel, our guide will meet you at the hotel lobby and accompany you to the Incheon International Airport for your departure.
